Monte Rosa along its south side is one of the most eligible areas for freeride in the western Alps.

Thanks to ski lifts reaching beyond 3000mts height, possibilities are dozens and suitable for every level of ski.

From a place where we take our first ski curves outside the slopes it can become, after little time, frame of great slopes with high technical and environmental challenges.

The slopes range the gamut from wide plateau and gorges leave space to little woods and

streets along the lowest slopes.
