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## Glaciers Safety



### Description

Moving on a glacier in security, means knowing how to bond correctly, choose the best itinerary and...know how to handle unforeseen events.

Falling in a crevasse is an unfortunate event but, when accurately prepared, it can not be a threaten to the security of the roped party and to the success of the ascent.

The security on glacier course will be held on a Monte Bianco or Monte Rosa glacier and will be based on 4 fundamental aspects:

- setting of a secure roped party

- hold in a fall

- snow anchorage setting

- companion rescue

Once the course is over you'll know how to move on a glacier with more security, evaluate the

kind of roped party to set depending on the conditions and crevasse won't worry you as much.

**\*Minimum number**

Course starts with minimum 3 participants.

How to behave if a partner falls in a crevasse?

A whole day dedicated to strategies and crevasse rescue manoeuvres to move with more ease on glaciers.
